

## RENO QRP GROUP SLOW SPEED CW QRP NET REPORT

Hi all;

The log of our last slow speed NET on Sept. 5, 2024, is attached.

The NET was held from Huffaker Hills trail Head altitude of 4620 ft. My Hidden Valley Park still closed, it looks like I will be able to operate there two weeks from now, I will be happy to get back there.

One big problem with Huffaker Hills is Rattle Snake Mt is due north of that location, blocking signals to Walla Walla, WA. All though this location was a bad choice I had fun setting up at a different location. Every location presents its own problems, for those of you who work in the field, you will find more joy setting up at different locations.

The NET started on time at 10:00 am on 7.045 MHZ.

The noise level was S2 SFI 216A index 13 K index 2 Xray at C3.9

There were 6 QNI today Mike WA6ARA, Woody K1LB, Joe KM6HJP, Bob KA6NSN, Krystal AJ6GC I/O, (I am including Dave KI7SJE I learned from e-mail that he tried several times to QNI, but I didn't hear him)

First up was Mike who was at his cabin in the high Sierras, at Kennedy Meadows. Mike was using his K2 at ten watts. Mike to me was 599 but he received me at 339.

Next was Woody also in the field at a POTA site in Humboldt-Toiyabie US 4391 using his IC 7300 at ten watts into his EFHW ant we both at 599 woody was having a nice day with the weather being nice.

Joe was in the field about 2 miles from Doyle, CA in the Plumas Forest his rig I the IC7300 at 10 watts antenna is the EFHW inverted "L" his weather was sunny and clear. Joe and I were both 599.

At last call Bob reported in at 599 from his home in Quincy, CA He was operating his FT 747 at ten watts into his COBRA antenna at 20 ft. His weather was sunny with a temp at about 60 degrees F.

The NET was closed at 10:38

## RENO QRP GROUP SLOW SPEED CW QRP NET REPORT

Hi all;

The log of our last slow speed NET on Sept. 19, 2024, is attached.

The NET was held from Hidden Valley Park elevation 4560 ft a few feet lower than my usual spot. Cleanup work is continuing from the flash flood. The last NET was held at Huffaker Hills Trail Head elevation of 4620 ft.

The NET started on time at 10:00 am on 7.045 MHZ.

The noise level was S2 SFI 163A index 12K index 3 Xray at C3.9

There were 7 QNI today Mike WA6ARA, Joe KM6HJP, Bob KA6NSN, Roy W7HJL, Derek W7DLZ, Dave KI7HJE, and Woody K1LB.

First up was Mike operating in the field at his cabin in Kennedy Meadows, CA. Using his K2 at ten watts into his end fed random wire, Mike was solid 599 to me. Mike gave a fine report including the weather clear at 62 degrees F.

Next was Joe from his field location about 2 miles from his home in Doyle, CA His QTH in the Plumas Forest area using his IC 7300 at ten into his EFHW inverted "L" solid at 599.

Bob also in the field on Sloat Road use to be Rattle Snake Road just north off SR-70. Bob used this FT 757 at ten watts into EFHW antenna, good and strong signal at 599. Bob included the weather in his report being clear sunny temp at 60 degrees a find day for the field.

Roy from Walla Walla, WA using his K3 from his home at 10 watts into his vertical, Roy was 579.

Roy included RST for mike, Joe, Bob and Dave. Roy reported the weather being clear and a temp od 60 degrees F a very good report from Roy.

Dave checked in from his home in Lemmon Valley using his yaesu FT DX at ten watts. Derek included the weather in his report. Derek was stronger than usual from his home to me, he said that he was using his new 80 MTR doublet at 35 ft. At time his signal peaked to 599 + 10.

Dave from Walla Walla, WA was in the field in a park near his home. He was using his KX3 at ten watts to his temporary 40, 20 M trap Dipole at only 10 ft. It worked find as is had good copy at 569.

Last was Woody also in the field at a POTA location US439. He was using his IC 7300 at ten watts into his EFHW his signal was 599.

The NET was closed at 10:56 AM.

All check ins had good signals with five operating in the field, this has been a fine NET today, thanks to all who QNI.
